**THOUGHT QUESTION**

Paul normally used someone else to do the actual writing of his epistles (Rom. 16:22; 1 Cor. 16:21; Col. 4:18; 2 Thes. 3:17), yet he wrote this letter with his own hand in large letters (Gal. 6:11). Why, possibly, did he need someone else to write for him (Gal. 4:14-15; 2 Cor. 12:7-10)? Why would he make the special effort to personally write this letter to the Galatians?

# Galatians 6:6–18

## Sowing and Reaping, and Closing Thoughts

- 1) What responsibility does the one taught the gospel have toward those who teach the gospel (Rom. 15:25-27; 1 Cor. 9:4-14)? When we give to the preaching of the gospel, what do we reap (2 Cor. 9:6-14; Phil. 4:16-19)?
- 2) We deceive ourselves and try to mock God when we think what? (cf. Hosea 8:7; 10:12,13; Prov. 11:18,19; 22:8; Numbers 32:23)
- 3) How do we “sow to the Spirit”? What is the yield of sowing to the Spirit?
- 4) Why do brethren grow weary in doing good? What is the remedy for weariness in well doing (cf. 1 Cor. 15:58; Heb. 12:1-4; 2 Cor. 4:16-18)?
- 5) If you have opportunity, what must you do? Why must we “especially” do good to those of the “household of faith”?
- 6) Those who sought to make everyone happy were trying to force circumcision so that they might avoid what (6:12)? Was their motivation a sincere desire to follow the law (6:13)?
- 7) In what should we boast (cf. 1 Cor. 1:31; Jer. 9:23-24)?
- 8) If I have been crucified to the world, what will change?
- 9) Compare 5:6 with 6:15 – What truly “avails” in Christ?
- 10) The church in 6:16 is called the “\_\_\_\_\_ of God.”
- 11) Why did Paul want to be left alone (6:17)?
