Joshua 10:1-27

- Who was the king of Jerusalem? (10:1)
- Why did they fear greatly the people of Israel? There's more than one reason! (10:1-2)
- Which kings / cities formed an alliance against Gibeon? (10:3-5, verse 6 calls these the "kings of the Amorites who dwell in the mountains.")
- What assurance did God give to Joshua? (10:7-8)
- **10:9** — Joshua therefore came upon them suddenly, having marched _____ from Gilgal.
- How did the Lord fight for Israel in this battle? (10:10-11)
- **THE SUN STOOD STILL!** How did this demonstrate Joshua's faith and his relationship with God? How was God fighting for Israel by keeping the sun from setting? (10:12-14)
- When Joshua returned to Gilgal, what report did he hear about the 5 kings? (10:15-17)
- What instructions did Joshua give to his forces before they dealt with the 5 kings? (10:18-21)
